SUBJECT: Active Resolutions

OBJECTIVE: Information Only

Issue

At the December 7, 2021 board meeting, Commissioner Barofsky recommended a review of Resolutions and Board Policies to ensure awareness of existing agreements or commitments. Board Policies were reviewed as part of the January 4, 2022 board meeting and as per current practice, will continue to be reviewed annually going forward. This memo serves as a review of Active Resolutions.

Background

Board Policy GP7 – Board Parliamentary Procedures sets forth the requirements for the use of resolutions for Board actions. The policy specifies that formal resolutions will be required when the Board takes actions of the following types:

- Rate increases or decreases:
- Approval of contracts for purchased power with a term of one year or more;
- Adoption of an Integrated Electric Resource Plan or update;
- Adoption of the Water Supply Plan or update;
- Adoption of a Water Master Plan or update;
- Adoption of Board Policies;
- Approval of the annual budget;
- Issuance of bonds or other debt instruments.
- Committees created and adopted by Board.
- Outside appointments adopted by the Board.
- Liaison appointments adopted by the Board.
- Advisory assignments adopted by the Board.

All other actions can be taken in accordance with the Bylaws using a simple motion and affirmative vote.

Discussion

The General Manager's office maintains a record of all Resolutions and the date of Board approval by calendar year. Additionally, a list of Active Resolutions dated 2015 to present is maintained by staff. The list of Active Resolutions is not inclusive of resolutions which adopted a policy or bylaw as these items stand on their own merit, nor does the list include items that are transactional in nature, such as past budget amendments.

The inventory of resolutions includes, but is not limited to, purposes such as the Board's annual appointments, legislative agendas, declarations of surplus, approval of price revisions, pricing structures and strategies, updates to signatories, bond authorizations, and Resolutions authorizing the General Manager to enter into agreements and/or perform, negotiate, and execute a variety of property decisions or transactions.

Following each board meeting, all newly approved Resolutions are evaluated and added to the Active Resolutions document as appropriate. Any annually recurring Resolutions are added, with the precedent Resolution removed.

The current version of the *Active Resolutions Dated 2015 Present* document is attached for your review. Subsequently updated versions are available upon request.
