Narrative:

In January 2012, the hydraulic hoist mechanism for Roll Gate 2 at Leaburg Dam catastrophically failed. Replacement of the hoist mechanism for gate 2 was completed in early 2015 and included installing a new gate hoist, including electric motor, gear train, braking system, variable speed drive, and ancillary devices.

No

In December 2014, the hydraulic hoist mechanism for Roll Gate 1 failed and left Roll Gate 1 in a closed position. After the failure of Roll Gate 1, the FERC directed EWEB to replace the hydraulic hoist mechanism for both Gates 1 and 3 with a new hoist mechanism similar to the recently installed mechanism for Gate 2.

Staff requested proposals and negotiated the scope of work and pricing with Knight Construction for the replacement of Gates 1 and 3. EWEB has executed the amendment for Gate 1 which was executed based on the emergency declaration; the costs associated with Gate 1 are \$1,503,016. To leverage the design, staff resources, and knowledge of our current contractor, EWEB staff has negotiated an Amendment to complete the work on Gate 3, the costs associated with Gate 3 are \$1,115,851.
