Narrative:

The Board is being asked to approve the direct purchase of **filter media** for EWEB's Hayden Bridge Water Treatment Facility from **Xylem Water Solutions USA**, **Inc.** EWEB Rule 6-0230 exempts water treatment chemicals and media for use in its Water Filtration Plant from bidding.

The Hayden Bridge Filtration Plant uses anthracite coal and silica sand filter media as its primary treatment barrier. Over time this filter media breaks down and requires replacement and/or replenishment. Historically, EWEB has purchased this filter media from FB Leopold (now Xylem Water Solutions USA, Inc.). Although there are other manufacturers of this filter media, the Xylem Water Solutions USA product has demonstrated superior performance. In 2009, EWEB personnel sought alternate sources for this filter media, and though a product matching the specifications of the Leopold media was found, performance life was considerably less. A significant volume is now required to rebuild the south filters (S1 – S6) and the funds for this purchase have been identified in the water capital improvement plan for 2016.

Staff issued a request for quote to Xylem Water Solutions USA, Inc. of Zelienople, PA in January, 2016 for the above-described filter media. If approved, Xylem Water Solutions will provide and deliver filter media as specified in the solicitation documents.

ACTION REQUESTED:

Management requests the Board approve the **purchase of filter media from Xylem Water Solutions USA, Inc. for the Hayden Bridge Water Treatment Facility.** This purchase is exempt from competitive bidding per EWEB Rule 6-0230. Funds for the filter improvements and filter media purchase were budgeted for 2016.
