



## *Income Eligible Leak Repair Assistance Program*

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The Income Eligible Leak Repair Assistance Program provides EWEB water customers with grants to pay a qualifying plumbing contractor to replace leaking plumbing fixtures, appurtenances and piping that would otherwise continue to leak and consume additional water unnecessarily.

Measures may include:

- Service line replacement
  - PRV replacement or installation (if one not present)
  - Installation of whole house Shut-off valve (if one is not present)
  - In house piping up to 5 ft. in length
  - Install, replace, or repair backflow prevention assembly which is directly connected to the service line
  - Replace faulty indoor appurtenances
- Replace faulty plumbing fixtures

Measures **NOT** included:

- Sprinkler system repair
- Replacement of all piping within dwelling
- Replacement of water heater

Upon approval of income eligibility, EWEB offers grants to property owner in the water service area as an incentive to complete approved plumbing repairs. The maximum incentive amount is \$5,000 for residential customers. To determine eligibility see the other side of this information flyer.

Grant funding is available to help limited income homeowners with replacing water service lines and repairing and replacing plumbing appurtenances inside and outside the home. To qualify income levels must be less than either 200% Federal Poverty Level or 60% Oregon Median Income. **To be eligible you must:**

- Be a EWEB water customer.
- Have a household income that falls below the following maximum levels.
