NARRATIVE:

The Board is being asked to approve a new price agreement with **Pennington Crossarm Company** for the periodic purchase of Douglas Fir Crossarms (as needed to replenish stock).

In January 2010, EWEB issued a formal invitation to bid for the periodic purchase of Douglas Fir Crossarms as the utility needs Crossarms for new installations or replacement of damaged units. Pennington Crossarm Company was the sole bidder and was determined to be a responsive-responsible bidder. The price agreement established unit prices that are used to replenish EWEB stock. Prices are reviewed annually and adjusted, if necessary, to compensate for economic escalation (i.e. increase to the cost of living or cost of materials).

Historical procurement data suggests that the total contract amount will be approximately \$187,900 over the total five-year period. The actual total dollar amount, however, is unknown and may be more or less than that estimated. Purchases will be based on need and not on any specific annual quantity. The annual cost will be within the amount budgeted for that specific year.

If approved, staff will purchase wooden (Douglas Fir) crossarms from this supplier as needed over the life of the contract, potentially five years. This contract is for one-year with the option, at EWEB's discretion, to renew for four additional one-year periods.

ACTION REQUESTED:

Staff requests Board approval of a new price agreement with **Pennington Crossarm Company** for the periodic purchase of Douglas Fir Crossarms (as needed to replenish stock). Funds for these purchases were budgeted for 2010 and will be budgeted annually.
