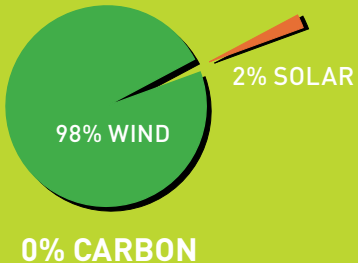

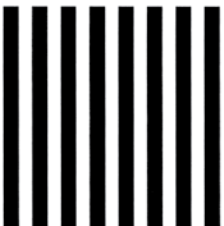

Being a part of EWEB Greenpower is a simple step that you can take to support sustainable energy. Join now and encourage renewable energy projects right here in the Northwest.

Here's why Greenpower is a smart choice:

1. Support renewable.

With Greenpower, you're joining with neighbors and local businesses to support green energy and reduce air pollution.

2. Buy local.

EWEB's renewable energy portfolio includes wind power projects in the Northwest and solar projects right here in Eugene.

3. Support education and research.

Greenpower supports education in sustainable energy and research into emerging renewable energy technologies. Among these Greenpower projects is a solar-powered charging station for electric vehicles at Lane Community College.

4. Small cost, big benefit.

You can make a difference for as little as \$1.50 a month, or you can choose a higher level of support for clean power.

The funding that is dedicated to Greenpower is placed in a reserve account that supports clean energy now and development of green energy technologies for our future.

Greenpower is a voluntary program and an easy and affordable way to help the environment. Each month, your EWEB Greenpower purchase will be listed on your electricity bill as a separate item.

Whether you are a residential or business customer, you have several options for supporting Greenpower:

- You can assign 100% of your electricity use to Greenpower with an extra one cent per kilowatt-hour premium. The average household uses 1,100 kilowatt-hours of electricity in a month and so would pay an additional \$11 a month. With this option, the Greenpower amount will vary from month to month depending on how much energy you use.
- Or you can choose blocks of Greenpower. **There are two block sizes:** 1,000 kilowatt-hour blocks for \$10 each (the average household uses about one block this size per month, and use by businesses varies widely), or 100 kilowatt-hour blocks for \$1.50 each. Just pick the size of the block, and then select the number of blocks you'd like based on your electricity usage. With this option, the Greenpower amount is constant from month to month.
