

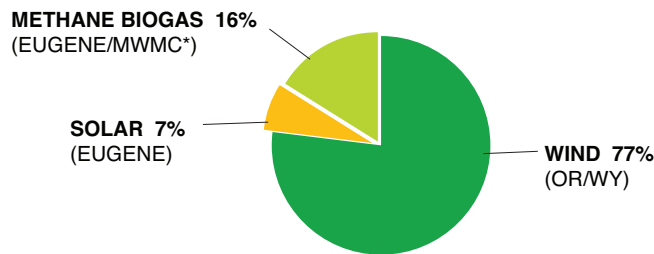

Green-e Energy certified new renewables in EWEB Greenpower for 2012*



*MWMC = Metropolitan Wastewater Management Commission

New renewables come from generation facilities that first began commercial operation on or after January 1, 1997.

For 2011, the renewables for EWEB Greenpower were 79% wind from Oregon and Wyoming, 15% from methane biogas in Eugene (the Metropolitan Wastewater Management Commission), and 6% solar from sources in Eugene.

The average residential EWEB customer uses 1,023 kWh per month. The average mix of resources supplying EWEB includes: Hydro (70%), Efficiency (13%), Nuclear (7%), Wind (4%), Coal (3%), Natural Gas (2%), and Biomass (1%). Sources: EWEB and the Bonneville Power Administration.

How will I be billed?	Your pricing charge for EWEB Greenpower will be listed on your utility electricity bill as a separate line item.
How will my electricity bill be calculated?	Usage rate: \$0.01/kWh for 100% of customer use Block rate: \$1.50 per 100 kWh or \$10.00 per 1,000 kWh block
How much will my total electricity service cost, including utility charges?	The average EWEB residential customer uses 1,023 kWh per month. The charges for the average customer will be \$10.23 in addition to their electricity charges (1,023 kWh x \$0.01 = \$10.23). Customers can also choose 100 kWh blocks of EWEB Greenpower for \$1.50 per block or 1,000 kWh blocks for \$10.00 each.
Will my electricity rates change over time?	The cost of EWEB Greenpower is additional to your electricity rate, and is set by EWEB's publicly elected Board of Commissioners. The cost is subject to change as a result of public hearings before the Board.
What fuel sources will be used to generate my power?	Please see <i>Energy Resources Product Content Label</i> .
Is there an early termination fee?	There is no termination fee.
What length of agreement/contract is required?	There is no minimum contract length.
What other fees might I be charged?	There are no additional charges.
Am I required to buy Greenpower?	No, EWEB Greenpower is strictly a voluntary program.
