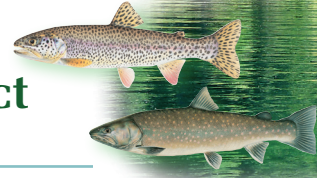


Carmen-Smith Hydroelectric Project



Relicensing Agreement: Recreation

The Eugene Water & Electric Board will improve and protect recreational opportunities as part of relicensing its Carmen-Smith Hydroelectric Project. Here are the highlights:

- Reconstruct and improve Ice Cap Creek Campground near Carmen Diversion Reservoir.
- Reconstruct and improve Lakes End Campground (boat access only) at upper end of Smith Reservoir.
- Reconstruct and improve Trail Bridge Campground at Trail Bridge Reservoir.
- Construct a visitor center in Trail Bridge Campground (kiosk with interpretive displays).
- Construct new day-use areas (picnic tables, rest rooms, etc.) at all three reservoirs.
- Construct new day-use area at Beaver Marsh, below Carmen Diversion Dam. This includes a new parking area.
- Make data from new river-flow gauges available for kayakers and other whitewater enthusiasts.
- Increase stream flows in Smith River; periodic “flushes” of water available for kayakers.
- Improve or construct new boat ramps and fishing-access areas at all three reservoirs.
