Rethink. Recycle. Reward.

Chances are, the older refrigerator or freezer in your basement or garage is running up your utility bill by as much as \$150 a year. Recycle it, reduce your energy use and keep harmful materials out of the environment. We'll pick it up for free and you'll pick up \$30.

JACO will recycle at least 95 percent of each unit. You will earn a \$30 rebate and save on your electric bill.

1. **Oils and refrigerant** — Remove and heat oils to distill refrigerant, ship to qualified handler.
2. **Mercury-containing devices** — Remove mercury containing switches and thermostats, ship to qualified handler for recycling.
3. **Glass** — Remove, crush and recycle glass shelving.
4. **Refrigerator unit** — Cut appliance into several pieces to separate and recycle metal, plastic and foam.
5. **Metals and plastics** — Remove and recycle approximately 150 lbs. of metal and 25 lbs. of plastic.
6. **Compressor** — Remove capacitor for recycling.

How to recycle and earn \$30:

1. Contact **JACO Environmental** at **866-444-8907**, or go to **eweb.org/recyclerefrigerator** to schedule a date to have your old appliance picked up.
2. JACO will haul away and recycle your old, operating refrigerator or freezer for **FREE**.
3. JACO will mail you a **\$30 rebate** check within 14 days of pick up.
4. If you need a new refrigerator or freezer, shop for one that's ENERGY STAR® qualified to receive an **additional \$15 rebate** and save on your monthly energy bill. ENERGY STAR® refrigerators use 20% less energy than other models. Visit eweb.org/saveenergy/home/refrigerators for a rebate application and savings calculator.

The program is available to customers of Eugene Water & Electric Board (EWEB) in Oregon. Refrigerators and freezers must be in working condition and must be a minimum of 10 cubic feet in size, using inside measurements. EWEB contracts with JACO Environmental, an appliance recycler, to pick up and recycle refrigerators and freezers. Customers must own the unit(s) being recycled. Limit two units per residential address. ENERGY STAR® refrigerators and freezers are not eligible. A check will be mailed to the customer within 14 days after the appliance collection.
