



EWEB Community Care Veteran Transitional Housing Assistance

The Eugene Water & Electric Board's temporary Community Care Veteran Transitional Housing Assistance is effective Oct 1, 2011, and will continue until funding is depleted or by Sep. 30, 2012, whichever occurs first.

General Information

The Veteran Transitional Housing Program provides a "per bed" electric utility assistance payment to non-profit facilities within EWEB's service territory as identified by a Tax Exempt Form filed and approved by the City of Eugene Transitional Housing.

Eligibility Requirements

- 501c3 (non-profit) status and provide documentation with application
- Veteran Transitional Housing Tax exemption form, filed with the City of Eugene, including number of permanent beds at each Vet Housing location
- Be located in EWEB's service territory and account must be in the name of the nonprofit vet housing facility
- Provide permanent beds for homeless veteran individuals and/or families
- Submit a completed EWEB application
- Application must be signed by authorized person from vet transitional facility

VETERAN TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROVIDER APPLICATION

EWEB's 2011 Community Care Program includes a per bed electric utility bill-assistance payment for eligible veteran transitional housing providers within EWEB service territory. A one-time payment, based on the number of permanent beds provided at the location, may be applied to eligible accounts within 30 days of receipt of the completed application. This authorization will continue while I participate in any EWEB funded programs and for the following 12 months.
