EWEB Unveils New Climate-Conscious Options

As an EWEB customer, you're already using clean, renewable energy and investing in McKenzie Watershed protection. But together we can do more.

EWEB recently launched Green Options, a line of voluntary, carbon-conscious programs based on feedback from customers who want to do more to support renewable energy and take action on climate change.

INVEST IN RENEWABLE ENERGY

EWEB's traditional *Greenpower* program supports rooftop solar and other environmental projects here in Eugene. Our new *Cleanpower* program allows you to purchase renewable energy certificates (RECs) that help green the grid by displacing dirty energy sources with renewable resources like wind and solar.

RIDE ELECTRIC

Reduce air pollution and have fun getting around on an electric bike with EWEB's \$300 e-bike rebate.

SHARE AN EV

Our partnership with Forth Mobility will bring three electric car sharing stations to Eugene, including a dedicated station for residents of St. Vincent de Paul's Iris Place.

GROW A FOREST

Support a local 140-acre carbon forestry project to expand understanding of natural climate solutions and protect the McKenzie Watershed.

OFFSET YOUR CARBON FOOTPRINT

After you maximize ways to save energy and reduce your carbon footprint, you can neutralize your remaining emissions with carbon offsets added right to your EWEB bill.
