SUBJECT: Renewal of EWEB Education Grant Program Intergovernmental Agreements

Background

The EWEB Education Grant Program provides funding for water and energy education activities in four area school districts: Eugene (4J), Bethel, Springfield and McKenzie, and for Lane Community College (LCC). More than \$462,000 is currently dedicated to this program annually to fund water and energy education activities. The five-year Inter-Governmental Agreements (IGAs) used to operate this program have expired and are up for renewal.

The EWEB Education Grant Program, established in 1995, replaced long standing "contributions-in-lieu-of-tax" (CILT) payments to these four school districts. A similar change was made in 1998 for LCC. The program is one of the more significant examples of community service benefits derived from public ownership of energy and water utilities in Eugene. Funded projects have promoted an awareness of our environment and an ethic of wise use around water and energy resources. The program is extremely popular among educators, parents and students, has established EWEB as a leader in community education for youth, and stands as an excellent example of how public ownership supports the community we serve.

Discussion

Renewal of the five-year Inter-Governmental Agreements with the school districts and LCC are designed to continue funding these programs at the current 2015 budgeted levels, providing annual grants as follows: Eugene (4J)-\$247,000; Bethel-\$77,000; Springfield-\$47,000; McKenzie-\$21,000 and for Lane Community College-\$70,000. Grant payments are contingent upon annual budget approval by the EWEB Board. Language in the IGAs provide EWEB with the ability to increase or decrease grant payments, as part of the annual budgeting process approved by the Board.

Requested Board Action

The five-year IGA with the Eugene 4J School District exceeds the \$1 million limit for consent calendar items. All five agreements are included for the Board's consideration in the Dec. 1, 2015, Renewal of EWEB Education Grant Program Intergovernmental Agreements action item. Management requests Board approval of the five-year IGAs with Eugene (4J) School District, Bethel School District, Springfield School District, McKenzie School District and Lane Community College.

Narrative:

In 2009, the board approved a five-year education grant to LCC for their Energy Management Program. The EWEB/LCC Education Grant Program is designed to replace the voluntary "in-lieu-of-tax" payments with an education services grant system whereby LCC establishes base funding for their Energy Management Program. In turn, EWEB receives greater support for education activities that are directly connected with EWEB's mission. The program has been extremely successful for EWEB, LCC, and participating students.

Staff has negotiated an IGA that outlines the expectations and the process regarding disbursement of grant funds. If approved, EWEB will make grant payments to Lane Community College annually in the amount of \$70,000 over a 5-year period for a total amount of \$350,000.
